Report from the District Enrollment Director

On October 14, 2002, the DCMW sponsored its annual reception at the Holiday Inn Metrodome in Minneapolis for all area high school juniors and seniors interested in attending Dartmouth College. Angela Parker represented the Admissions Office and explained how applications are reviewed and how selection decisions are made. Nearly seventy students and parents were in attendance. They were seeking both general information about Dartmouth College as well as answers to specific questions. One significant change in the admissions process this year is that Dartmouth has eliminated its separate application forms and will now only take the "Common Application Form." Angela also made visits to individual schools in the Twin Cities and northern Minnesota throughout that week.

The Early Decision process is underway, with decisions to be announced by December 15. Regular applications are due by January 1.

The Club will begin the alumni interviewing of candidates in mid-January. They may not refer to it as the "Form 6" anymore, but the College does want as many interview reports on candidates as possible.
